## 2021 DOBLO'S FARMERS MARKET SCARECROW COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

<b>Entries Open:</b>	1 May 2021
<b>Entries Close:</b>	1 June 2021
<b>Max Number of Entries:</b>	Maximum of 2 Scarecrows per Class – entry is FREE
<b>Competition Eligibility:</b>	Participation is open to all Kindergarten, Primary and Secondary School Students
<b>Requirements:</b>	Maximum height no more than of 2.5 metres Scarecrow must be free standing on a base
<b>Delivery of Exhibits:</b>	Monday 7 June 2021 to the Show Office
<b>Judging:</b>	Wednesday 9 June 2021 by Committee and Sponsors All scarecrows will be on display around the grounds for duration of the Rockhampton Agricultural Show (9-11 June) and then be displayed at Doblo's Farmers Market from Saturday 12 June until Sunday 20 June.
<b>Winners Announced:</b>	10am Saturday 19 June at Doblo's Farmers Market
<b>Collection of Exhibits:</b>	Monday 21 June 2021 from Doblo's Farmers Market

### SCARECROW TIPS

You could theme your scarecrow:

- Traditional Scarecrow
- Famous People
- Rockhampton Show, Indigenous, Australian, Scary or Funny to name just a few. Use your imagination and have fun.

Materials you could use include:

- old clothing
- hay or straw
- farm tools
- a mop or broom for frame
- old pieces material or newspaper
- old socks and shoes for feet
- gloves for hands
- pillow case for head and draw on face
- string or twine will hold it all together

Use lots of accessories to make your scarecrow unique!



At least one teacher must be nominated as the main point of contact between the school and the Rockhampton Agricultural Show team.

Exhibits must be delivered and collected at the schools own expense.

Scarecrow entries cannot be hung or mounted to any buildings or fixtures. All entries must be self-supporting. Construction must be suitable for display outdoors over three days. No scarecrows can be planted or placed directly into the dirt.

Teacher assistance is permitted if the use of tools (power or other) is required.

## **JUDGING**

Each scarecrow will be judged on the following:

1. Originality
2. Innovative use of recycled materials
3. Workmanship

## **PRIZE MONEY**

The scarecrow competition has a prize pool of \$1,500 with 1<sup>st</sup> place for kindergarten, primary and secondary school entries.

In the event of a tie, the prize money will be split between the two winning entries.
