#### **APICULTURE REGULATIONS**

#### **REGULATIONS APPLYING TO APICULTURE SECTION**

#### General

- 1. Exhibits will not be accepted without entry fees.
- 2. It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure clear and correct details are provided on the Entry Form at time of entry.
- 3. All prize money will be paid via cash payment at the Exhibitors Stand during
- 4. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show (12-14 June 2024) or during the exhibit collection times stated in the schedule. Any prize money not collected by 30 June 2024 will be forfeited and put towards the next year's Show.
  - a. Note: Prize money will not be handed out without the winner's card being presented to the Show staff.
- 5. Entry Fees \$3.00 per entry which includes the cost of the jar (applicable to honey entries only)
- 6. Exhibitor Cards must be securely attached to all exhibits. These will be distributed to you via email.
- 7. All exhibits must be delivered to the Showgrounds between Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June and Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and will be received in the Administration Office.
- 8. Exhibits can be collected from the Stewards in the Agricultural Hall on Saturday, 15 June from 9.00am to 12.00pm. The stub of the Exhibitor Card must be retained and presented for easy identification.
- 9. All exhibits unclaimed one week after the Show will be forfeited. No responsibility will be taken for any exhibits left at the Showgrounds more than 24 hours after the end of the Show.
- 10. Management will not be held responsible for the cost of returning Apiculture entries.
- 11. Management and its agents reserve the right to disqualify any entry which in their opinion fails to meet the entry criteria. They also reserve the right to move any entry to its correct class or to consolidate multiple classes into a single class where the number of entries is low.
- 12. The Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13. All care will be taken, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to any exhibit by the management or their agents.
- 14. Any entry received soiled, damaged or otherwise unfit for display will not be exhibited.
- 15. Entry to Pavilion before Show by authorised personnel only.

#### **Biosecurity**

- 1. Movement Records with Hive Identification Numbers must be provided on entrance to the Rockhampton Show.
- 2. The handling of animals must be in accordance with the Rockhampton Show Biosecurity Plan
- 3. If the Chief Biosecurity Officer requests documents, information or directs a person to undertake an action, these requests must be complied with.
