NOTE: If you cannot pay online, CASH payments can be made at the Rockhampton Regional Council City Hall Customer Service office Monday to riday 9am - 4pm from 06 May to 27 May 2024.

# Step 2 Get your exhibits ready

Make sure to follow the guidelines in this schedule to ensure your prints are ready with the exhibitor cards filled out and attached to the back of the print. If your print does not meet the guidelines, you will be notified and the print will be disqualified from the section. Mounting your print to card/core board is optional and not a necessity for display.

<u>Note</u>: Exhibitor cards will be emailed to the email address you supply to Showday online after you have finalised your application, unless arranged with the Steward.

# **REGULATIONS**

# ENTRY SUBMISSION & PRESENTATION GUIDELINES \*\*READ THESE CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING\*\*

- Every print must be the original work of the entrant.
- Any print entered at any previous Rockhampton Agricultural Show is not permitted to be entered again.
- Maximum of 4 entries per class per person.
- Repeat submission of a print into multiple sections is not permitted.
- A print will be moved to a more suitable Class/Section instead of disqualification where possible.
- Entries must be printed on photographic quality paper and may be printed either by a commercial photo lab or from home. Prints on standard document printing paper will not be accepted.
- Complete the exhibitor cards on page 12 and adhere these to <u>the back</u> of each print right way up. Any unmarked prints will be disqualified.
- The title of the print on the information card MUST be the same as on the entry form.
- Any print damaged or otherwise unfit for display will be disqualified at the discretion of the stewards.
- Any print with title or name on the front of it will be disqualified.
- Prints do not need to be mounted on card or coreboard, if you choose to, the size of
  the backing and photo total <u>must not exceed</u> the section's specification (each section
  has different sizes, please check before entering a print).
- DO NOT use sticky tape or double-sided tape, the best adhesive is a strong glue or using self-adhesive coreboard.
- Prints with Velcro/string/clips or other mounting materials <u>will not</u> be accepted, to prevent damage to other prints.
- Prints in frames or on canvas will not be accepted.
- If there is insufficient space to display all prints preference will be given to prize-winning entries, then at the discretion of the stewards.
- Prints deemed unsuitable for public viewing will not be displayed.
- The entrant will be notified of any disqualification or change of section/class for any of their Prints.
- No late entries accepted.
- Failure to adhere to the guidelines will result in disgualification.

#### PRINT COLLECTION

- Any entries not collected on the designated day will be discarded unless other arrangements have been made.
- Entrants wanting return by post are required to include prepaid postage.
- Prize vouchers can be collected from Camera House in the Stocklands Shopping Centre after the show. Please take your winners cards with you for identification of prize
- ALL CARE WILL BE TAKEN, BUT NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO ANY EXHIBIT DURING TRANSIT.

The Rockhampton Agricultural Show or Rockhampton Photography Club will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by an exhibitor, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold Rockhampton Agricultural Show or RPC harmless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident.

**OPEN SECTION:** This section is open to all photographers, including members of any Photography or Camera Club, and professional photographers\*. High School and Primary School age who **are** members of a Photography or Camera Club may also enter photos in the Open Section.

**PUBLIC SECTION:** This section is for people who are NOT members of any Photography or Camera Club and/or who are NOT professional photographers High School and Primary School who **are not** members of a Photography or Camera Club may also enter photos into the Public Section.

**DISABILITY SECTION:** This section is for people with a disability who are NOT members of any Photography or Camera Club and/or who are NOT professional photographers.

**High School SECTION:** This section is for students in high school (or of high school age but have left school) including camera club members.

**Primary School SECTION:** This section is for students in primary school including camera club members.

\*A professional photographer is deemed as someone who advertises and sells their services and/or images to derive a living or maintain meaningful supplemental income. \*
