Key Information

1. Please note there may be some changes to classes, regulations and procedures from previous years. To ensure that there are no issues with your entries, please read this schedule carefully.
2. ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY | All nominations are to occur via online entry only. Please log onto [Showday Online](#) to nominate and pay for class entries. No on the day nomination facilities will be available. No cash payments will be accepted.
Nominations close Monday 8 June 2026.
3. ONLINE STABLE / CAMPING BOOKINGS | All bookings are to occur via Showday Online only. Please log onto [Showday Online](#) to book and pay. Please note if you require stallion stalls/larger stalls when booking online, make a comment in the available section. No cash payments will be accepted. Camping & Stabling Bookings close Friday 5 June 2026.
4. Access to camping sites / power will not be granted without your “Camping Access” form being presented to security. Your Camping Access form is available from the Rockhampton Showgrounds Admin Office on arrival .
5. SAWDUST | Hard timber sawdust will be supplied for the stables.
6. EXHIBITOR WRISTBANDS | Competitors will receive two (2) wristbands (1 for the competitor and 1 for the attendant) per horse nominated. Collect from the Horse Declaration & Registration Desk near the stable area. Wristbands are to be worn at all times for all entry into the Showgrounds. All others accompanying the competitor must present to a ticketing gate to purchase a ticket for entry. Wristbands are to be treated like cash. Any individual that has lost their wristband will need to purchase a replacement.
7. An Online Competition Schedule will be available to inform competitors of the number of entries/exhibitors in each class across the Horse Competition of the show. This schedule can be accessed by scanning the QR Code within the stabling area. It is the exhibitor’s responsibility to be marshalled on the Centre Ring Track and ready to compete in relevant classes.
Rockhampton Regional Council (RRC) is collecting the personal information you supply for the purpose of an online Horse Competition program which will be published via a QR Code. RRC deals with personal information in accordance with law, including the Information Privacy Act 2009.
8. All prize money will be awarded and available for collection from Centre Ring after the associated class has been judged. Competitors must sign to collect prize money. Any uncollected prize money from the corresponding day of competition can only be collected from the Showgrounds Administration Office located at Gate 1, 8am – 5pm Thursday 11 and Friday 12 June 2026. Any prize money not collected by 5pm Friday 12 June 2026 will be forfeited and allocated to the next year’s Show.

Camping/ Stable Information

9. Camp sites are priced at \$30 per night and include one (1) 15amp power outlet, two (2) access passes (for two people), and one (1) car pass.
Additional items may be requested as follows:
 - a. Additional power outlets: \$55 each
 - b. Additional access passes: \$5 each
 - c. Additional car passes: \$10 each
10. Stabling: \$15 per stable per day/night. Stables at the Showgrounds are available from Monday 8 June 2026 – Saturday 13 June 2026.
11. Stabling and camping outside of the above times is available at the CQLX Complex 16 Saleyards Road, Gracemere. Please contact Linda McMaster (0411 740 366) for CQLX stabling/camping options.
12. Bookings and payment to Rockhampton Agricultural Show are to be made on Showday Online and clicking 'Extras'.

Regulations

Privacy Statement

Rockhampton Regional Council (RRC) is collecting the personal information you supply for the purpose of Rockhampton Agricultural Show communications. RRC deals with personal information in accordance with law, including the Information Privacy Act 2009. Some of this

information may be given to customers, sponsors and event partners and listed on Council's website for the purpose of advertising.

General

1. Exhibits will not be accepted without payment of entry fees via Showday Online.
2. Competitors nominated in two (2) rings where times clash must make a choice of which event they are to compete in and, with the exception of championships, events will not be held up for late riders under any circumstances.
3. Only judges, stewards and volunteers are allowed to enter the Centre Ring marquee. Any exhibitors holding their horse must be held on the Centre Ring Track.
4. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show and its volunteers accepts no responsibility for exhibits and will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused by an exhibit. It shall be the condition of entry that any exhibitor will hold the Committee blameless and indemnified against any legal action arising from such accident.
5. All the exhibitors and attendants must obey the instructions of the Horse Committee while they or their exhibits are within the precincts of the horse pavilion and adjacent yards. If any person fails to carry out the instructions of the Horse Committee, then the Horse Committee may order the whole or part of the exhibits or any such person to be removed from the Showgrounds and may cancel the whole or part of the nominations of such person.
6. No horses shall be displayed or exposed for sale on the Showground without permission from the Horse Committee and they must compete in the Show.
7. Any exhibitor or competitor who competes in an event in which a person or animal has not been correctly nominated, will be liable to a fine or disqualification at the discretion of the Horse Committee. The owner of such animal will be considered equally guilty with the rider of the animal.
8. Judges reserve the right to judge classes on the circle as deemed appropriate by the Judges and Horse Committee. No further correspondence will be entered into.
9. The Horse Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge when deemed necessary and without notice.
10. In the event of there being no competition in a class the merit of the exhibit shall be the sole guide in awarding or withholding any prize, also if the merit of the exhibits in any class or championship is not, in the opinion of the judge, sufficient to entitle them to a prize, the judge may withhold any or all prizes.
11. No transfers will be considered under any circumstances except by measurement or Judge's classification, with the exception of show jumping entries where horses may be substituted.
12. No stallion may be entered in hack or riding classes, except where specifically stated in the schedule.
13. It is a request that all colts/stallions and filly/mares in led-in classes must be kept under control at all times with either bits or chains.
14. Foals accompanying their dams must be haltered and kept under control.
15. Horse floats will be permitted to load or unload horses at a special pick-up point on the corner of Graeme Acton Way and Exhibition Road. The time limit for the use of this area will be 30 minutes. Any vehicles in this area longer than 30 minutes will be removed at the owner's expense.

16. Any person breaking any of the rules will be liable to a fine or disqualification from any further competition, as may be decided by the relevant Disputes Sub- committee.
17. All Galloways must be over 14 hands and not exceeding 15 hands.
18. Ponies 12.2 hands and under must be ridden by riders under 18 years. Ponies over 12.2 hands can be ridden by an adult rider, unless otherwise stated.
19. All attendants must be suitably attired.
20. A Maiden is determined to be a horse that has never won a blue ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the time of nominations.
21. A Novice is determined to be a horse that has never won an Open Championship at any Agricultural Show at the time of nominations.
22. Competitors may elect to exhibit a horse as a show hack or show hunter, but not both at this show, unless specified in the program. Once the competitor has competed the horse as a show hack or show hunter, they must do so for the entirety of the show. The competitor will be disqualified if they do not follow this rule.
23. Any person, including a competitor or an exhibitor, who wished to lodge a protest, shall do so in writing to the Horse Committee Chair, together with the sum of \$50, within one hour of the completion of the event. Any person, whether competitor or not, who, in the opinion of the Horse Committee, behaves in an offensive, threatening or insulting manner, either inside or outside the ring, to any official of the Horse Committee or judge, shall be liable to disqualification from further competition and shall be liable to be removed from the grounds. The Horse Committee's decision will be final with no correspondence entered into.
24. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or add any event without notice.

Stabling

25. Stalls to be used for the stabling of horses only. **No stalls are to be purchased for gear, equipment, feed or other purposes than to stable livestock.** Stables could possibly be allotted for day of competition only. The Horse Committee cannot be responsible for the stabling of all horses. Preference will be given to travelling horses.
26. Exhibitors are not permitted to use any other stable other than those allocated to them. In the event of any person placing horses in boxes or stalls without authority, the horses will be removed, at once, from the Showgrounds by order of the Horse Committee at the owners' risk and expense.
27. The allocation of stalls and the movement of horses and gear to and from such stalls shall be under the control of the Stable Coordinator. Exhibitors not carrying out the instructions of the Stable Coordinator may, if so desired by the Horse Committee, be barred from competing and the animals concerned must be removed from the Showgrounds.
28. Sex of animal must be clearly stated when applying for stabling.

Horse Health and Age

29. Sound horses only will be accepted. Any animal which, in the opinion of the Horse Committee is not in a fit state to be exhibited, or showing signs of illness, may be rejected by them, and debarred from competing in the class or classes for which it is

- entered. Any animal rejected must be removed from the Showgrounds as soon as the exhibitor is notified.
30. Animal Health Declaration signed by the owner/rider must be completed and delivered to the Horse Declaration & Registration Tent (near the Stable Area). The Rockhampton Agricultural Show Committee has the right to refuse a nomination if there is no Health Declaration presented.
 31. All entrants MUST complete the *Horse Health Declaration Movement and Entry Form*. This form can be found on the www.rockyshow.com.au/Competitions/Animal-Competitions/Horses
 32. This can also be used as a Movement Record.
 33. Exhibitors must present any relevant proof of financial/current memberships & registrations to the Horse Declaration & Registrations Tent before competition begins.
 34. The use of hormones and/or tranquillisers is prohibited. Any exhibitors violating this regulation will be dealt with by the Committee.
 35. Cruelty to horses will not be tolerated. This includes excessive use of whip or spurs, rapping, excessive exercise or jabbing horse in the mouth excessively.
 36. Age of all horses to be computed as from 1 August 2026. Every horse foaled before 1st August in any year shall be deemed to be one year old on that date.
 37. The birth certificate of each competitor in classes where age is stipulated, must be produced if required.
 38. In any class for which a prescribed age is a condition, the only horses that can be entered or compete are those the age of which, calculated by clause 18, is in accordance with the conditions. No horses under or over the prescribed age can compete.
 39. Horses entered in any class for which a prescribed height is a condition, MUST be able to produce a Height Certificate if requested by the Chief Steward or Horse Committee.

Safety

40. All competitors must have their helmets mandatory tagged as per EA rules. This will be strictly enforced.
41. All people handling horses must be wearing enclosed footwear.
42. No scooters or electronic/motorised transportation devices/vehicles are to be used on the showgrounds. Competitors will be disqualified if they do not follow this rule.

Breed Association

43. All horses must be registered with the relevant Breed Association and the registration must be current. Competitors and owners must be current financial members of the relevant Breed Association. Papers, registrations and memberships must be provided with Horse Health Declarations to the Horse Declaration & Registration Tent (near the Stable Area).
44. A copy of current breed registrations and memberships of various associations must be submitted with Animal Health Declarations or able to be produced to the Horse Committee if requested. Exhibitors will be unable to compete in relevant breed/registration classes if current papers and documents cannot be produced.
45. The pedigree of all horses except those entered in the miscellaneous classes must be stated in the nomination.

46. The horse's microchip number must be included on the paperwork submitted to the Horse Declaration & Registration Tent – especially for those exhibitors who wish to contest any QOTT Competitions.
47. All horses entered for competition in stud classes must be registered in a stud book of their respective breed society recognized by the Royal National Association. Registrations papers (or copies) must be produced upon request. Where breed regulations require, nominations must be accompanied by breeding details.

Dogs

48. No dogs are permitted at the Showgrounds or at the camping area.

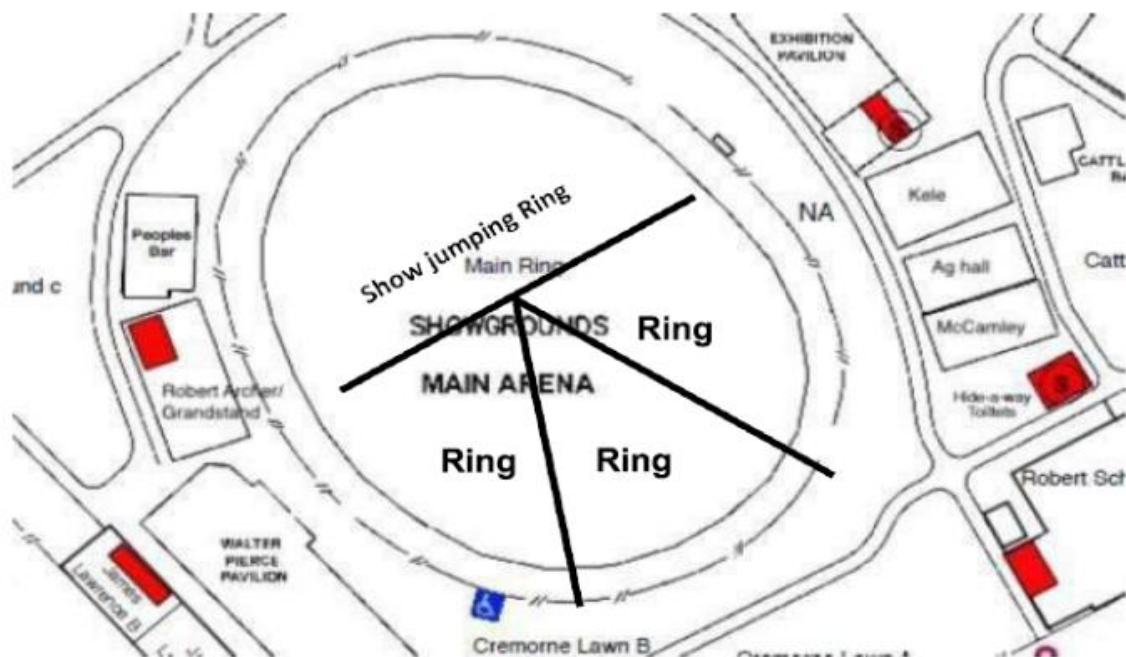
