REGULATIONS APPLYING TO HORTICULTURE SECTION

General

- 1. There will be no entry fee for the Horticultural section 2023.
- 2. All exhibits will be accepted from 9:00am 6.30pm on Tuesday 13 June 2023 at the Crowley Pavilion, Rockhampton Showgrounds. Exhibitors are asked to complete the entry form on Showday Online for respective entries.
- 3. **Prizes** Champion winners will receive a Rosette and Vouchers donated by the Rockhampton Horticultural Society and Doblos Farmers Market as stated in schedule.

- 6. After the exhibit has been staged it must not be interfered with without the permission of the Steward.
- 7. ALL exhibits in Classes 5101-5171 must have been grown by the exhibitor. Pot Plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor FOR AT LEAST THREE (3) MONTHS. The Committee reserves the right to take appropriate action where these conditions are found to have been contravened.
- 8. Exhibitors are asked to complete the online entry form for respective entries and manual complete the entry form and hand to appropriate steward.
- 9. All prize money will be paid during the exhibit collection times stated in the schedule. No prize will be handed out without a prize card.

BIOSECURITY

- 1. Exhibits cannot include invasive plants declared under either the Biosecurity Act 2014 or Rockhampton Regional Council Local Law 3 (Community and Environmental Management 2011.
- 2. In the case where a suspected invasive plant is present, the Chief Biosecurity Officer of the show shall be contacted to assess.
