POULTRY AND WATERFOWL REGULATIONS

REGULATIONS APPLYING TO THE POULTRY & WATERFOWL SECTION

- 1. Entry forms shall be signed by the exhibitor and give full contact details, description of exhibit and section and class number in which they wish to compete.
- 2. Entry fees MUST be paid with the entry and lodged with the Rockhampton Agricultural Show by the allocated time.
- 3. Exhibits must have enough food & water when they arrive, for the first day. Stewards will attend to the feeding and watering for the duration of Show.
- 4. Alternative collection times for birds must be arranged with Chief Stewards.
- 5. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving their reasons for doing so.
- 6. Any exhibit suffering from any infectious or contagious disease shall be reported immediately to the Section Manager who shall order its removal.
- 7. No decoration or award cards, except such as provided by/approved by the Committee shall be placed on any exhibit or affixed thereto.
- 8. Exhibits entered in the wrong class by the exhibitor may be transferred to the proper class by Managers/Stewards.
- 9. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show reserves the right to cancel or change any event or class or substitute a judge where or when deemed necessary.
- 10. All entries must be the Bona Fide property of the exhibitor on the date of entry. Entries are accepted entirely at owner's risk. Borrowing birds for show purposes or sales for limited periods will render both parties liable for disqualification.
- 11. For the duration of the show, all exhibits will be in the custody of the Chief Steward and shall not be touched or handled by the owner or any other person. Any exhibitor seen to be breaching this clause may forfeit their nomination and any prize money awarded.
- 12. Waivers must be signed and handed back to the Steward before the Rockhampton Agricultural Show will take possession of any exhibit for the duration of the show.
- 13. Exhibits can be collected from the steward in the Kele Pavilion on Friday, 14June between 5.00 pm and 8.00pm.
- 14. 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners will be presented with a place card.
- 15. All prize money will be paid via cash payment by the steward the poultry during the Rockhampton Show (12-14 June 2024). Any prize money not collected by 30 June 2024 will be forfeited and put towards the next year's Show.
 - Note: Prize money will not be handed out without the winner's card being presented to the Show staff.
- 16. Prizes will be paid as:
 - a) Champion, \$20 & sash
 - b) Reserve Champion, \$10 & sash
 - c) Grand Champion Poultry, \$50
 - d) Grand Champion Waterfowl \$50
 - e) Supreme Champion Poultry bird of show, \$100.00 and sash
 - f) Reserve Supreme Champion Poultry bird of show, \$50.00 and sash
 - g) Most successful exhibitor trophy kindly donated by Phil Peel Jewellers
 - h) Junior exhibitor of show (under 18yrs) (soft or hard feather) and PJ Pet Barn voucher
 - i) People's choice Ribbon & Prize
- 17. All matters in dispute shall be subject to the decision of the Committee / Chief Steward / Section Manager appointed for such purposes.
- 18. No protest will be considered unless lodged with the Manager, in writing within one hour of completion of the event, enclosing \$50.00 which will be forfeited to the Rockhampton Agricultural Show should the protest be considered frivolous.

Protests will only be received from competitors in the class in dispute.

- 19. Any person, whether competitor or not, who in the opinion of the Committee behaves in any offensive or threatening manner, either inside or outside, to any official or judge or member of the public, shall be liable to disqualification from further competition and shall be liable to be removed from the grounds.
- 20. Any exhibitor or his agent who shall make a false report and give misleading information or suppress necessary information respecting any exhibit shall be held to have forfeited any prize gained by these means. The exhibit and the exhibitor together with the agent may be disqualified and the matter referred to the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies.
- 1. All birds will be watered and fed by the society whilst penned.

SPECIAL POULTRY AND CAGED BIRDS REGULATIONS

For the conduct of Poultry and Caged Birds competitions at QCAS affiliated Queensland Agricultural Shows Where there is a conflict between these regulations and the regulations and rules of the local Agricultural Society, the rules of the Affiliated Agricultural Society prevail.

These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Regulations contained in this schedule.

NOTICE TO INTENDING EXHIBITORS

- 1.1. Birds can only be removed from showing area with the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 1.2. Any Bird entered in the incorrect class can, at the discretion of the Chief Steward, be re-entered in the correct class.
- 1.3. No birds to be removed or handled without the Steward's permission.
- 1.4. Any Bird found to have been tampered with may, at the discretion of the Stewards and Committee, be disqualified
- 1.5. Eggs remain the property of the affiliated Agricultural Society.
- 1.6. No trimming, plucking or dyeing of feathers, staining of legs or any fraudulent practice will be allowed.
- 1.7. Every Exhibitor will be deemed responsible for the condition in which his/her exhibit appears in the pen. It shall be permissible for Exhibitors to dub male game fowl and game bantams.
- 1.8. Birds must be true to breed, no cross breeds.
- 1.9. Banded birds are eligible for judging.
- 1.10. Junior Exhibitors must pen and unpen their own entries.

AGE OF EXHIBITS

2.1 Birds 12 months and over will be judged as adults.

JUDGING

- 3.1 Judging standards will be those recognised by the Australian Standard or the British Poultry Standard where applicable.
- 3.2 Exhibitors are not to talk to Judges during judging.
- 3.3 Judges are not to judge classes in which they have entered.

- 3.4 An Exhibitor shall not compete nor show any bird in a section if the bird has been owned or leased by the Judge or a member of the Judge's immediate family or if the Judge is the Exhibitor's employer or business partner within three (3) months prior to or during the holding of the Show.
- 3.5 An Exhibitor shall not compete if the Exhibitor or any bird being shown by the Exhibitor has been given tuition by the Judge or the Judge's business partner within three (3) months prior to or during the show.
- 3.6 An Exhibitor is ineligible to compete, if the Exhibitor has employed or has been employed by or has been a business partner of the Judge of the Section within three (3) months prior to or during the holding of the Show.
- 3.7 A Judge shall not visit the bird-housing complex of the Agricultural Society, nor the owners, nor inspector discuss any animal entered in the Show prior to or during the judging of the relevant section.

Biosecurity

- 4.1 All poultry and caged birds bought onsite must comply with the requirements of the 2024 Rockhampton Show Biosecurity Plan.
- 4.2 If an animal becomes ill, it may be moved to the designated quarantine area at the direction of the chief biosecurity officer or a veterinarian.
- 4.3 If the on-call veterinarian for the Rockhampton Show is required, it is the owner of the exhibit who is responsible for payment directly to the veterinarian.
- 4.4 Exhibitors must complete an animal health declaration on the heath status of the animal on entry to the showgrounds.
- 4.5 If the Chief Biosecurity Officer requests documents, information or directs a person to undertake an action, these requests must be complied with
- 4.6 All Birds are to be free of lice and disease. Any affected Birds must be moved to a quarantine area or collected by owner immediately.

NOVICE JUDGES

Class 6688 Novice Judges Prize: Voucher & Sash

Entries are open to people interested in judging exhibition poultry and have not adjudicated at any more than three (3) shows. After gaining entry into the Show, entrants are to present to the Honorary Steward in the Poultry Pavilion at 11:00am on Thursday 13th June 2024. Entrants are required to judge four Poultry classes. The highest score novice judge must be between 15 years to 25 years as of 1st May 2024.

Competition Rules - Poultry Young Judges

To be eligible to compete in the Meat Sheep & Poultry State Finals, competitors must comply with ALL rules noted below. Agricultural Society and Coordinators are to ensure relevant rules are consistently enforced for competitions under their control.

- 1. Age of Competitors
 - 1.1 Competitors must be aged between 15 years of age and under 25 years as at the 1st May in the year of the State Finals.
 - 1.2 Competitors under the age of 18 years must have the approval of a parent or guardian to compete and the appropriate waiver signed on the nomination form.
 - 1.3 Different age classes may be added to programs at local show level. These classes will not be recognised at State Finals.
- 2. Eligibility to Compete
 - 2.1 Competitors must meet one of the following criteria
 - a) A Queensland resident for a minimum of three (3) months prior to competing;
 - b) Attend a Queensland educational institution;
 - c) Residing interstate but can prove a connection with a Queensland Agricultural Society and satisfy one of the following criteria:
 - i) Permanent address has a Queensland postcode;
 - ii) Competitor or parents are active working members of that Agricultural Society.
 - iii) To be eligible to compete at State finals, competitors must have won in a similar class at a local agricultural show competition.
 - 2.2 Previous National winners are ineligible to compete at state level of competition.
- 3. Entry Forms
 - 3.1 Entry Forms are available from the Queensland Ag Shows Website www.queenslandshows.com.au
 - 3.2 Local Agricultural Show Stewards are to:
 - a) Ensure Entry Forms are completed for all competitors and waivers are duly signed by Eligible persons;
 - b) Forward WINNER and RUNNER UP Entry Forms to the Queensland Ag Shows Office competitions@queenslandshows.com.au within 7days of the competition conclusion.
- 4. National Competition (Procedures & Guidelines)
 - 4.1 Rules are set by Agricultural Shows Australia (ASA) for National Finals. The Agricultural Shows Australia Rules (Handbooks) can be found on their website <u>www.agshowsaustralia.org.au/member- resources/national-competitions-guidelines/</u>
