# 1. Only judges, stewards and volunteers are allowed to enter the Centre Ring marquee. Any exhibitors holding their horse must be held on the center ring track.

- 2. The pedigree of all horses except those entered in the miscellaneous classes must be stated on the class ticket. Sound horses only will be accepted.
- 3. Any person, including a competitor or an exhibitor, who wished to lodge a protest, shall do so in writing to the Horse Committee Chair, together with the sum of \$50.00, within one hour of the completion of the event. Any person, whether competitor or not, who, in the opinion of the Horse Committee, behaves in an offensive, threatening or insulting manner, either inside or outside the ring, to any official of the Society or judge, shall be liable to disqualification from further competition and shall be liable to be removed from the grounds. The Horse Committee's decision will be final with no correspondence entered into.
- 4. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or add any event without notice.
- 5. Prize money will not be paid to any person other than the winners. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure prize money is collected from the Horse Steward prior to leaving the Show on Friday, 14 June 2024.
  - Note: Prize money will not be handed out without the winners' card being presented to the Show staff.
- 6. No transfers will be considered under any circumstances except by measurement or Judge's classification, with the exception of Show Jumping entries where horses may be substituted.
- 7. Competitors nominated in two rings where times clash must make a choice of which event they are to compete in and, with the exception of championships, events will not be held up for late riders under any circumstances.
- 8. Application for camping space must be made on Showday Online with the relevant fee of \$28.5 per day. Camping is available in Victoria Park. Caravans/Trailers must be placed by 4.00pm on Tuesday, 11 June 2024.
- 9. Stabling must be booked on Showday online at the cost of \$15 per stable per night. Owing to the limited number of horse stalls, stalls will be allocated in order of receipt of entries/bookings. STALLS TO BE USED FOR THE STABLING OF HORSES ONLY, and could possibly be allotted for day of competition only. The Committee cannot be responsible for the stabling of all horses. Preference will be given to travelling horses.
- 10. Exhibitors are not permitted to use any other stable other than those allocated to them. In the event of any person placing horses in boxes or stalls without authority, the horses will be removed, at once, from the Showgrounds by order of the Ring Committee at the owners risk and expense.
- 11. The allocation of stalls and the movement of horses and gear to and from such stalls shall be under the control of the Stabling Steward. Exhibitors not carrying out the instructions of the Stabling Steward may, if so desired by the Ring Committee, be barred from competing and the animals concerned must be removed from the Showgrounds.
- 12. Due to WHS concerns, no camping is allowed in the stable area. The only exception is the Red Coats. All parking and camping outside the Showgrounds.
- 13. No stallion may be entered in hack or riding classes, except where specifically stated in the schedule.
- 14. Age of all horses to be computed as from 1st August. Every horse foaled before 1st August in any year shall be deemed to be one year old on that date.
- 15. All horses entered for competition in stud classes must be registered in a stud book of their respective breed society recognized by the Royal National Association. Registrations papers (or copies) must be produced upon request.

Where breed regulations require, nominations must be accompanied by breeding details.

- 16. In any class for which a prescribed age is a condition, the only horses that can be entered or compete are those the age of which, calculated by clause 18, is in accordance with the conditions. No horses under or over the prescribed age can compete.
- 17. Competitors must report to the Steward in charge of the respective judging ring to have the class ticket collected, otherwise the animal and/or competitor will not be allowed to compete.
- 18. Horses entered in any class for which a prescribed height is a condition, **MUST** be able to produce a Height Certificate if requested by the Chief Steward or Management Committee.
- 19. Each exhibitor must state on their class ticket the number of class in which they intend to compete, and full particulars of the horses entered in each class if applicable.
- 20. In the event of there being no competition in a class the merit of the exhibit shall be the sole guide in awarding or withholding any prize, also if the merit of the exhibits in any class or championship is not, in the opinion of the judge, sufficient to entitle them to a prize, the judge may withhold any or all prizes.
- 21. The Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge where deemed necessary and without notice.
- 22. Foals accompanying their dams must be haltered and kept under control.
- 23. Horses shall be paraded on the days and at the time indicated in the official program.
- 24. All the exhibitors and attendants must obey the instructions of the Horse Committee while they or their exhibits are within the precincts of the horse pavilion and adjacent yards. If any person fails to carry out the instructions of the Horse Committee, then the Horse Committee may order the whole or part of the exhibits or any such person to be removed from the Showgrounds and may cancel the whole or part of the nominations of such person.
- 25. No horses shall be displayed or exposed for sale on the Showground without permission from the Horse Chairperson and they must compete in the Show.
- 26. The birth certificate of each competitor in classes where age is stipulated, must be produced if required.
- 27. Any animal which, in the opinion of the Committee Stewards is not in a fit state to be exhibited, or showing signs of illness, may be rejected by them, and debarred from competing in the class or classes for which it is entered. Any animal rejected must be removed from the Showgrounds as soon as the exhibitor is notified.
- 28. The use of hormones and/or tranquillisers is prohibited. Any exhibitors violating this regulation will be dealt with by the Committee.
- 29. Horse floats will be permitted to load or unload horses at a special pick up point on the corner of Graeme Acton Way and Exhibition Road. The time limit for the use of this area will be thirty (30) minutes. Any vehicles in this area longer than 30 minutes will be removed at the owner's expense.
- 30. All exhibitors must ensure that their entry tickets are correctly filled out as these will be used to collect prize money. Any exhibitor or competitor who competes in an event in which a person or animal has not been correctly nominated, will be liable to a fine or disqualification at the discretion of the Horse Chair or Chief Steward. The owner of such animal will be considered equally guilty with the rider of the animal.
- 31. Any person breaking any of the rules will be liable to a fine or disqualification from any further competition, as may be decided by the relevant disputes subcommittee.
- 32. Sex of animal must be clearly stated when applying for stabling.
- 33. The Rockhampton Agricultural Show and its volunteers accepts no responsibility for exhibits and will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused by an exhibit. It shall be the condition of entry that any exhibitor will hold the Committee blameless and indemnified against any legal action arising from such accident.

- 34. All Galloways must be over 14 hands and not exceeding 15 hands.
- 35. Ponies under 12.2 hands must be ridden by riders under 17 years. Ponies over 12.2 hands and over can be ridden by an Adult rider, unless otherwise stated.
- 36. All attendants must be suitably attired.
- 37. It is a request that all colts/stallions and filly/mares in led-in classes must be kept under control at all times with either bits or chains.
- 38. A Maiden is determined to be a horse that has never won a blue ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the time of nominations.
- 39. A Novice is determined to be a horse that has never won an Open Championship at any Agricultural Show at the time of nominations.
- 40. Cruelty to horses will not be tolerated. This includes excessive use of whip or spurs, rapping, excessive exercise or jabbing horse in the mouth excessively.
- 41. Dogs are to be leashed or otherwise effectively restrained from roaming on the grounds. Failure to adhere to this rule could result in the dog being collected by Local Laws.
- 42. All Horse Competitors must have their helmets mandatory tagged as per EA rules. This will be strictly enforced.

#### *Competitor's* Please Note:

- All prize money will be paid via cash payment at the Horse Stewards Office during the Rockhampton Agricultural Show (12-14 June 2024) or during the exhibit collection times stated in the schedule. Any prize money not collected by 30 June 2024 will be forfeited and put towards the next year's Show.
  - Note: Prize money will not be handed out without the winner's card being presented to the Show staff.
- All entrants **MUST** complete the Animal Entry Form. This form can be found <u>here</u>. This can also be used as a Movement Record.
- Judges reserve the right to judge classes on the circle as deemed appropriate by the Judges and Steward. No further correspondence will be entered into.

• Animal Health declaration signed by the owner/rider must be completed and delivered to the Biosecurity Officer. The Rockhampton Show Committee has the right to refuse a nomination if there is no Health Declaration presented.








# **Working Horse Patterns**

- 1. Trot from A with light rein
- 2. At B Canter circle to left
- 3. Simple change at B, three q cle to right and continue straight on to C
- 4. At C Stop and roll back to left 5. Canter straight to D and Stop and roll back to right
- 6. Canter to E, Stop, settle and back up 4 paces
- 7. Walk to Judge on lose rein
