Please read carefully as changes have been made.

- 1. All exhibits in this section must be genuinely hand-worked articles, unless otherwise stated.
- 2. Any entry received soiled, damaged or otherwise unfit for display will not be exhibited.
- 3. Exhibits will not be accepted without entry fees.
- 4. Entry Fees \$2.00 per entry plus \$1 administration fee per exhibitor
- 5. **Exhibitor Cards** must be securely attached to all exhibits. Quilts/Wall hangings to be securely attached to the bottom right hand corner wrong side of article.) These will be sent to the email you provide Showday online, on completion and payment of your Showday Online application.
- 6. Quilts and wall hangings will not be accepted without a rod pocket
- All exhibits must be delivered to the Showgrounds on delivery date. NO
 early or late nominations or deliveries will be accepted.
- 8. Exhibits will **not be available** for collection by exhibitor prior to Saturday, 15 June 2024. Exhibits can be collected from staff in the James Lawrence Pavilion on Saturday, 15 June from 8.00am to 12.00pm. The stub of the Exhibitor Card must be retained and presented for easy identification.
- 9. No Responsibility will be taken for any exhibits left at the Showgrounds more than 24 hours after the end of the Show.
- 10. All prize money will be paid via cash payment at the Show Office during the exhibit collection times stated Saturday 15 June between 8.00am & 12.00pm. **Any prize money not collected** by 30 June 2024 will be forfeited and put towards the next year's Show.
 - Note: Prize money will **not** be handed out without the winner's card being presented to the Show staff.
- 11. To collect your prize money you **MUST** present your winners card to the Show office.
- 12. Management will not be held responsible for the cost of returning Arts & Craft entries.
- Management and its agents reserve the right to disqualify any entry which in their opinion fails to meet the entry criteria. <u>They also reserve</u> the right to move any entry to its correct class.
