REGULATIONS

REGULATIONS APPLYING TO THE COMMERCIAL CATTLE SECTION

General

- 1. Cattle must be polled or completely dehorned with no sign of horn
- Cattle must be delivered to the Rockhampton Showgrounds on Tuesday, 11th June 2024 – between 7.00am & 12.00pm & weighing completed by 4pm.
- 3. All cattle must be NLIS compliant before arrival to the Rockhampton Showgrounds.
- 4. Separate waybills, health papers, including NVD are required.
- 5. Cattle should be presented free of ticks.
- 6. The breed of the cattle entered must be stated on the entry form.
- 7. All classes are restricted to two (2) entries per Exhibitor, the exception of Class 8019 with 1 pen entry only allowed.
- 8. All cattle will be mouthed, and colour tagged by your preferred Agent **PRIOR** to arrival at Showgrounds.
- 9. Handling of cattle after unloading at the Showgrounds will be at the discretion of the Prime Cattle Committee Stewards. Cattle will be weighed after unloading in order of arrival provided the owner, a representative or adequate instruction is available for classing.
- 10. Cattle must be nominated to a class prior to release from the crush.
- 11. Nomination close Tuesday 28th May 2024, mouthing to commence 11th May 2024.
- 12. Cattle must be of good temperament.
- 13. Cattle will be fed by the Committee at cost to Exhibitor.
- 14. All prize money will be paid at the Presentation evening on Wednesday 10th June 2024.
- 15. Cattle bought onto the Rockhampton Showgrounds must comply with the requirements of the 2024 Rockhampton Show Biosecurity Plan.
- 16. If an animal becomes ill it may be moved to the designated quarantine area, at the discretion of the Chief Biosecurity Officer or a Veterinarian.
- 17. If the on call vet for the Rockhampton Show is required the owner of the animal is responsible for payments to the veterinarian.
- 18. The show PIC is to be used when entering the grounds. QGRH0079
- 19. If the Chief Biosecurity Officer requests documents, information or directs a person to undertake an action, these requests must be complied with.

JBAS requirements for cattle

- All cattle entering the Rockhampton Agricultural Show must be a JBAS score of 6, 7 or 8. This score must be disclosed in the entry form under the 'Current Health Status' column.
- Management of JBAS at Rockhampton Agricultural Show is the exhibitor's responsibility, and exhibitors should understand the management options for Johne's disease and these should be identified in their own biosecurity plans.

Exhibitors and livestock attendants, will be provided with an <u>Exhibitor's Wristband</u> on the following entries: < 3 hd - 1 band, 4 to 6 hd - 2 bands, 7 to 9 hd - 3 bands, >9 hd - 4 bands.
